

# FINISH

**FINISH TIMER / SPOTTER:** one person can do this, two shifts.

**JOB:** Spot runner finishing, logs his/her time and BIB# (no names ) , sends Control crads and log in batches to RESULTS crew.

**NOTE:** there is now a serial (BIB) number on both the stub and the control card, put there by registration. use this number instead of runners name.

**NOTE:** Finish crew should spot people who are new, or have had difficulty (MSP, DNF), and try to find an experienced person to help them review their course. This will keep people coming back and alert us to any safety problems.

## **FINISH EQUIPMENT:**

**LARGE "FINISH" SIGN displayed facing incoming runners**

synchronised watch from starter

Finish Log, pens and pencils

## **PREP:**

set up sign

get Watch from Starter

set up close to finish, where you can see the "GO" control

## **PROCEDURE:**

**Put the finish time and runner # on the Finish Log and collects Control cards.** All other work is done in batches by the Results Table.

**NOTE:** \*The New Finish Log is marked by quadrants, lower left = 1 etc, Please fillin order, tear off and pass a batch at a time with the unchecked Control Cards to the Results tabulator)

- 1.: **Spot runner(s) finishing, put time(s) on the Finish Log\*, and \_then\_ log the runner(s) BIB#** from their control card.
- 2: Batches control cards (10) with quadrants from the LOG. and sends to RESULTS table
- 3: That's all! -- No need to write time on control card or compute elapsed, ( but do it if you have spare time)
