This will be people's first stop. It can be just displays or be manned.

- Welcome and help people 'orientate' themselves give out LAOC web and USOF info etc
- Have runners read the important DISPLAYS
  - CS notes
  - MD notes
  - (etiquette, time limit, correct course)
- Safety and Time limits

   Safety bearing
   Course Closure = controls are removed
   3 hours limit = be back
   ALWAYS Check in before leaving

Target shooters, Poison oak, animals, cliffs etc

- Sell T-shirts
- Point out different areas. Registration (next stop) Beg clinic Safety Check/ Map distribution Start Finish
- Be prepared to discuss Skill Levels (but Beginners will get this at Clinic)

What's in a color etc Length is not = difficulty

Groups and Newcomers wanting to do ADVANCED courses should be vetted for suitability. Sometimes they just want a long run. Explain advanced courses are challenging navigation; we want them to be safe and have a successful run.

LAOC permits Groups and Newcomers on Advanced courses in most circumstances.

Advise those with limited navigational skills to do Orange or if they want a long run Yellow +Orange , Orange+Brown or Brown+Green **not** Red or Blue!
